QUARTERLY FATAL REPORT:

None.

Lt. McCormick: Follow up item from last meeting. Blood test results back from state laboratory on fatal accident that occurred on I43 and Highland. Test showed driver was a .22 blood alcohol content.

STATE OFFICIAL'S REPORT:

Andrea Loeffelholz-fatal accidents for this year have gone down side wide to 275. This is the lowest for the past three (3) years. Motorcycle and pedestrian fatalities have gone up. Ozaukee County has a total of four (4) fatalities as of this date.

Laws that being introduced:

Racial profiling for law enforcement has been repealed.

Bill introducing OWI reimbursement for blood draw from driver. Criminalize first offense OWI if over .15, increase penalty for second offense.

Bus drivers no longer can use cell phones while driving school bus.

Law of the Month:

July-Ignition Interlock, August-Obey Traffic Signals, September-School Bus

Governor's conference in August 2011. Grants for 2012 will be forwarded to agencies shortly. Possibility of state doing multi-jurisdictional grants.

Lt. McCormick inquired about the K-2-synthetic marijuana legislation. Loeffelholz will check into it and forward information.

LOCAL OFFICIAL'S REPORT:

Check advised that the project on Pioneer Road to Wausaukee Road will start mid-August. Should be completed by early November 2012.
