TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES**

Mark Roherty called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. at the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Lobby Conference Room 101.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Mark Roherty, meeting properly noticed. Kim Voeller confirmed. Rick Olig moved for the adoption of the Agenda. Lt. Justin Kaas second, all ayes.

PUBLIC COMMENTS/CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATIONS:

Lt. Kaas shared with the committee his interactions with citizens voicing safety concerns about the increased speeds on Riverbend Road in Grafton. State Trooper Simpson discussed public safety concerns in the Town of Cedarburg near the intersection of Hwy I and Sheboygan Road, where there is no sidewalk and the speed is currently 45 mph. Jon Edgren noted that the speed limit was already lowered in 2018 and he would not suggest lowering it again at this time. He would suggest looking into other alternatives such as an asphalt path or sidewalk.

State Informational Items:

Dave Brantner gave an update on the Hwy 33 & I project. Construction would begin in July/August of 2022.

An update was given by Dave Brantner on the I-43 Expansion: Preliminary work will begin in July 2021. Expansion will encompass I43 from Silver Spring to Hwy 60. Discussion followed on the possible detour options.

Rick Olig discussed the Power Point informational slides he presented regarding YTD County & Statewide Crash Statistics, Predictive Analytics for the top 5 county high crash probability locations, Mapping, Legislative Updates, and Upcoming Events.

Local Information Items:

2021 Construction I-43 lane expansion – Jon Edgren provided handouts and explained the Project Sequencing & the Basic Overlay of Construction. He also discussed projects near Newburg and the Town of Port Washington, along with an overview of upcoming project in 2022-2025.

There was discussion regarding the paving of the old Hwy 57 (Columbia Road) from 1st Ave in Grafton to Cedarburg.
