**OZAUKEE COUNTY
TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES**

Mark Roherty called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. at the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Lobby Conference Room 101.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Mark Roherty, meeting properly noticed. Kim Voeller confirmed. Tom Grabow moved for the adoption of the Agenda. David Brantner second, all ayes.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM 1/27/20: Tom Grabow moved to approve. Dave Brantner second, all ayes.

ACTION ITEMS: None

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Quarterly Review of Fatal Accidents:

There was one Fatal Accident in Ozaukee County to Review for 1st Qtr 2021. Lt. Millbach briefly described the accident, as a two vehicle crash, occurring on March 23. The driver of one of the vehicles, fled the scene, was found about an hour later, was transported to the hospital, but pronounced dead a short time later. The report stated he died of internal injuries.

State Informational Items:

Trace Frost discussed the Power Point informational slides he presented regarding YTD County & Statewide Crash Statistics, Predictive Analytics for the top 5 county high crash probability locations, Upcoming Mobilizations, Legislative Updates, and Upcoming Events. There was active discussion regarding motorcyclist involved crashes, demographics, and high speed pursuits.

Dave Brantner gave an update on the Hwy 33 & I roundabout project. Construction is still slated for July/August of 2022.

Dave Brantner also gave an update on the I-43 Expansion: Work zone prep will begin this summer. Expansion will encompass I43 from Silver Spring to Hwy 60.

Local Information Items:

Warren Guettel discussed the upcoming county projects: Repaving County Trunk KW in the Town of Port to the town of Belgium will begin in June; in July Cty Trunk Y from Newburg to north to Cty Trunk A

Although there were no known active speed studies, there was discussion on a possible upcoming speed study of Hwy 60 (Juice's Ghostown Restaurant) to Hwy C. Warren Guettel will follow up with Jon Edgren and they will give an update in July.

There will also be an update in July on the project of Hwy W in Saukville to 33 along the river. Although this project is still in the beginning stages, there are public hearings being planned. We will include this on the July agenda.

Mark Roherty brought up the procedure going forward for officer elections for this committee. Kim Voeller noted that elections are held in even years, but there was some inconsistencies as to which month the elections take place. Chris Ohlis suggested that elections take place in January of 2022, but we will put the nominations on the October 2021 agenda.

ADJOURNMENT:

Motion made to adjourn the meeting. Chris Ohlis moved to adjourn the meeting. Lt. Milbach second, all ayes.
