### **CJCC Draft Meeting Minutes – August 9, 2021**

The Criminal Justice Collaborating Council met in Room 240 of the Ozaukee County Justice Center on Monday, August 9, 2021 from 1:15 pm – 2:15 pm. Joining via phone was also an option.

#### **Call to Order/Proper Notice/Adoption of Agenda:**

Chair, Judge Paul Malloy called the meeting to order at 1:18 pm.

**Approval of Minutes:** A motion was made by Mary Lou Mueller to approve the May 26, 2021 meeting minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Rhonda Gorden.

#### **Coordinator Report:**

Ms. Mohr reported that:

- New Public Health Strategist will be starting August 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Will be taking over Valerie Grimm's positions as Ozaukee County's CJCC Coordinator
- Fall Drug Take Back Day will be held Saturday, October 23 at Ozaukee County Transit Center and CUW School of Pharmacy
  - Event will be advertised
- Washington County Drug Treatment Court Update
  - Washington County Drug Treatment Court (DTC) had its' first graduation on July 15, 2021.
  - The program started in early 2020 and consists of 5 phases to help individuals with serious substance abuse problems to improve their life and stay out of prison.

Judge Malloy provided comment on the increase in methamphetamines and fentanyl along I-43. Gas stations and fast food restaurants along I-43 are popular stopping places and those having possession are often getting pulled over in northern counties (Ozaukee, Sheboygan, and Brown).

Kevin Hingiss provided comment NARCAN use is up.

**Financial Report:** We need to use remainder of budget by end of the year.

**TAD Program Update:** Ms. Muelemans reported that Sirona has been transitioning to seeing clients in person rather than a virtual setting. Sirona will use August as a transitions month for this, and they hope to have all

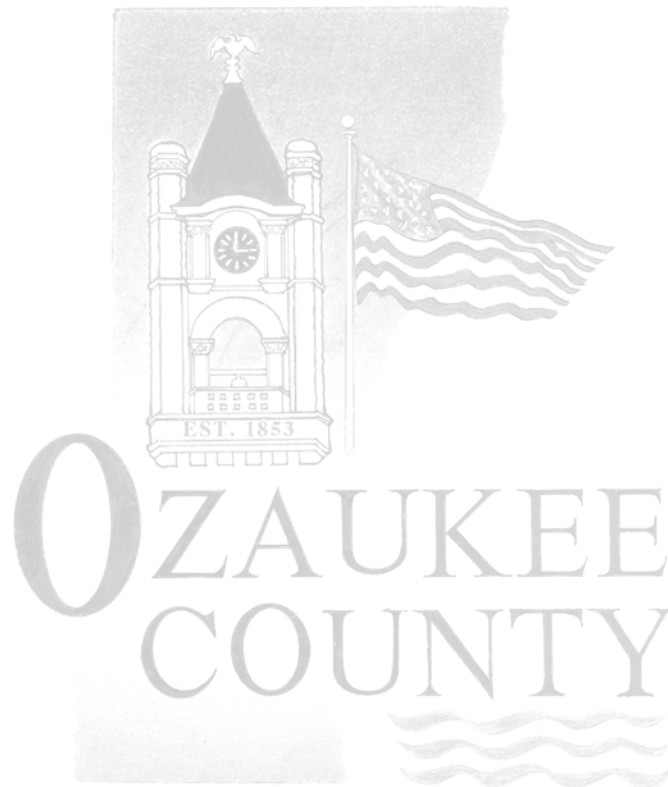
