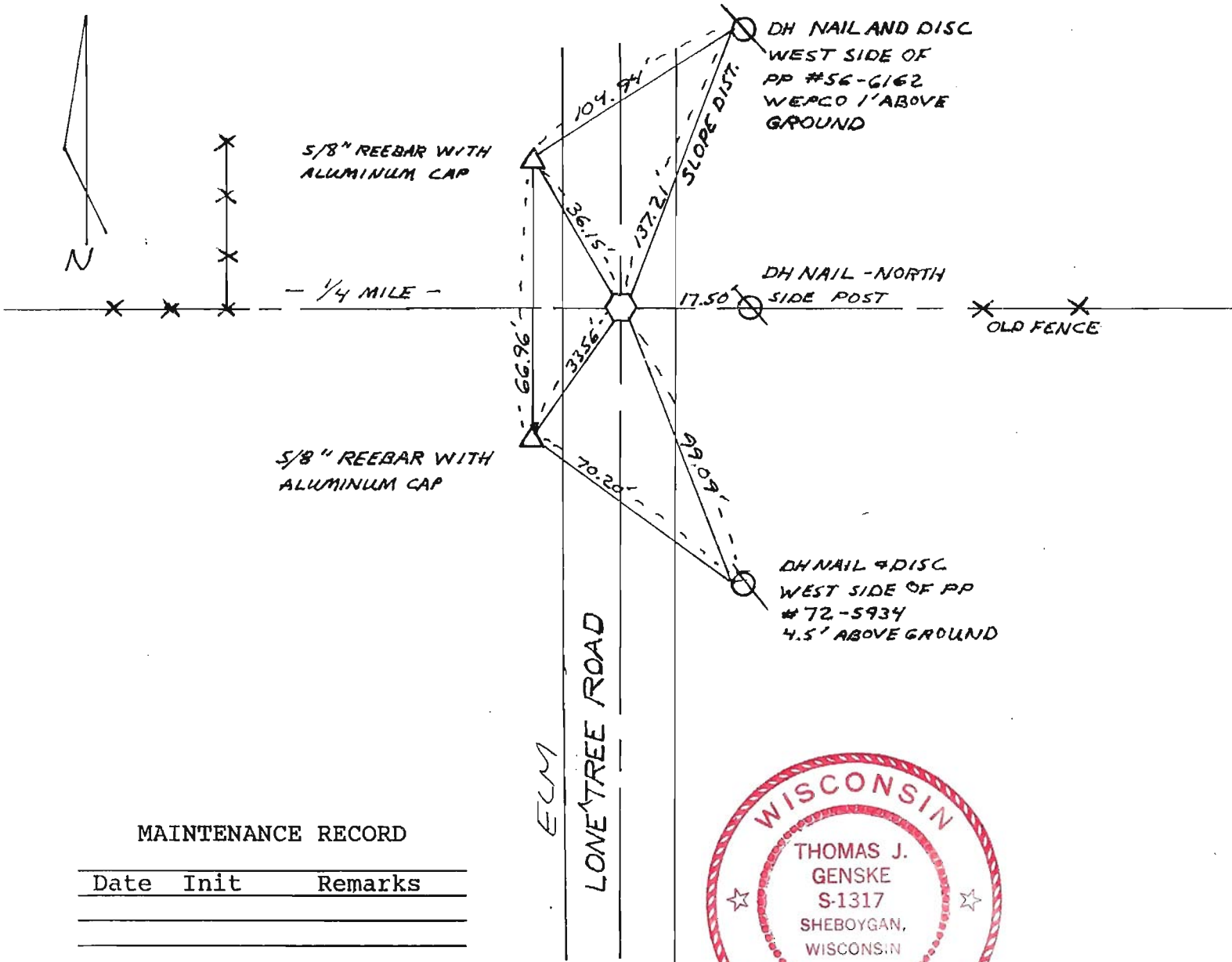

Excavated a seven foot by five foot area one foot below natural ground at one quarter lines intersection. Nothing else was found. Excavated a five feet by five feet area one foot below natural ground at fence lines to the east and west extended nad on center of gravel road. Nothing else was found.

Accepted testimony from George Jacoby, and eighty year old property owner, on location of old fences. (one post still standing) Used extension of old fence lines and centerline of gravel road as center of section and set a six inch square concrete monument with cross on top at this location.
