****Updated 11-04-20 @ 1:15 pm****

The vehicle operated by the VICTIM of this homicide was a 2013 Kia Optima, 4-door, white in color. Stock photos of the vehicle make and model are attached.

It is known that the vehicle entered I43 northbound from STH 32 in the Town of Grafton at approximately 6:36 pm and traveled northbound on I43. Between STH 33 (exit 96) and Northwoods Rd. in the Town of Port Washington an incident happened between an unidentified vehicle and the victim's vehicle. A group of approximately 4 or 5 vehicles were seen traveling northbound I43 in the direct vicinity of the victim's vehicle. It is also believed that the victim's vehicle was traveling at or below the posted speed limit.

In addition, the Sheriff's Office continues to request assistance from the public to provide any information regarding the identity of a witness vehicle that was observed traveling northbound on I43 at a high rate of speed immediately after the incident. The vehicle exited at CTH H in Port Washington (exit 100) and came to an abrupt stop at the top of the ramp almost striking a vehicle that was travelling southbound on CTH H at the intersection. The unidentified witness vehicle then turned north on CTH H then south onto I43 southbound.

The victim of this incident was identified as 41-year-old JOSHUA TERRY from the City of Cedarburg.

The Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office continues to request assistance from the public to provide any information regarding this incident. If you were traveling on I43 northbound or southbound between STH 33 (exit 96) and CTH H (exit 100) around 6:40 pm on Friday, 10-30-20 and you have information regarding any vehicles that may be involved in this incident please contact the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office at 262-284-7172.

The investigation is ongoing and no further information is available for release at this time.

****Updated 10-31-20 @ 2:00 pm****

The victim of the incident was identified as a 41-year-old male subject from the City of Cedarburg. Investigation of the scene revealed minor vehicle contact had occurred. This resulted in an interaction between the two drivers where the victim was shot on the side of the roadway. The victim ultimately succumbed to his injury and was pronounced dead on scene.

The incident is being investigated as a homicide. The Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office is requesting assistance from the public to provide any information regarding the incident, specifically regarding a vehicle of interest that was observed traveling northbound on I43 at a high rate of speed immediately after the incident. The vehicle exited at CTH H in Port Washington (exit 100), then traveled back southbound on I43.

On Friday, October 30th, 2020, at approximately 6:40 pm the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a possible vehicle vs pedestrian crash on I43 northbound at Northwoods Rd. in the Town of Port Washington.

A deceased male subject was located. The offending vehicle left the scene prior to Deputies' arrival. The circumstances surrounding the incident are suspicious and the deceased subject was not struck by a vehicle.

The Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office is asking for help from the public from anyone who may have witnessed this incident, or was driving in the area and heard or saw anything out of the ordinary. We are specifically interested in any witnesses who may have observed a vehicle traveling northbound on I43 at a high rate of speed immediately after the incident, exited at CTH H in Port Washington (exit 100), then traveled back southbound on I43.
