

Tree Selection For Golf Course and Parks Memorial Donations

- White Oak (*Quercus alba*) – red/maroon fall color
- Bur Oak (*Quercus macrocarpa*)
- Chinquapin Oak (*Quercus muehlenbergii*)
- Swamp White Oak (wetter areas like near the willows) (*Quercus bicolor*)
- Serviceberry spp. (native variety) (*Amelanchier spp.*) – red/orange fall color, white spring flowers
- Kentucky Coffee Tree (*Gymnocladus dioica*)
- Sugar Maple (*Acer saccharum*) – red/orange fall color
- Black Cherry (*Prunus serotina*) – yellow fall color
- Ironwood (*Ostrya virginiana*) – yellow fall color
- Eastern White Pine (*Pinus strobus*)
- White Cedar (*Thuja occidentalis*)
- Blue Beech / Musclewood (*Carpinus caroliniana*) – orange/yellow fall color, low growing tree, tolerates shade
- Tamarack (*Larix laricina*) – yellow fall color, planted in wetter areas near ponds, etc., deciduous evergreen
- Common Witch Hazel (*Hamamelis virginiana*) – low growing tree, tolerates shade, yellow color in fall
- Quaking Aspen (*Populus tremuloides*) – yellow fall color, better planted as more than one, quick growth
